Welcome

Guest Mr. Voris presented to the Boosters upcoming changes at the fair that may impact Pizza Wagon profits. Pizza Cottage is interested in selling pizza at the fair and they will be near the steer barns and Mr. Voris is concerned about possible impact on our profits. Mr. Voris indicated that Mr. Tipton, owner of the Pizza Cottage, is open to meeting with boosters after the fair and may be willing to make a donation for any difference in profit due to the Pizza Cottage booth. Mr. Voris will arrange a meeting with Booster President, Christina; Pizza Wagon Chair, Marcie; and Pizza Cottage representative to discuss possible partnership options.

Secretary's report: Jill emailed out the meeting minutes from August to executive committee and music staff.

Treasurer's Report: Jacien presented the current account balances. Motion to approve the report by Melissa. Second by Marcie. Motion carried.

Music Department Report: Middle school music will be having a fundraiser through Century Resources within the next two weeks. Money will be due up front. Julian reported that there was a paperwork issue with payment of Rachel Bigham and Jay Fant for their support in working with the competition band and the school district will not be able to pay them anymore this year. Julian requested boosters cover the remainder of their contract expenses to pay for choreography and music arrangement. He requested \$500 to pay Rachel and \$750 to pay Jay. Motion made by Marcie Dennis, second by Melissa Burton. Motion Carried. Kylie Ogg requested boosters support the music program at Bremen with purchase of a metallophone to replace broken equipment. Cost would be \$1135 plus \$30 shipping. Motion made by Melissa, second by Marcie. Motion carried.

Concessions: Music boosters worked with Cross country to cover the Falcon Invitational on September 5th. The two groups worked well together and split the profit for the evening.

Varsity letter updates: Melissa indicated that they are still awaiting shipment but she continues to communicate with the vendor to try to speed the process along.

Concession: The last two weeks of September are going to be very busy. Julian and Kylie offered to work Volley for a Cure on Tuesday Sept 26. We will continue to reach out to volunteers.

Inventory List: Jacien is working on a list of equipment that FUMB owns and may want to sell to Athletic Boosters as conclusion of this fall season.

Senior Banquet: Will be October 27th. Christina is working to get a group of under classman parents to organize and manage this event.
