- Students who display the Falcon Five qualities will have the opportunity to be recognized by our staff. Those that go above and beyond our expectations will have a postcard filled out and be entered into monthly drawings. All postcards completed by staff members will be sent home at the end of the month, so be watching your mailbox!
- Any student who receives a postcard will be eligible for our Falcon Excellence Lunch and also to be selected as our Student of the Quarter. Teaching teams will select students from each grade level to participate.
- Each grade level will also be working toward building level goals which include:
 - 85% of the grade level having no disciplinary actions (demerits, office referrals, etc.)
 - An Attendance Rate of 96% or higher
 - 60% of the grade level maintaining a 3.0 GPA or higher
- We will track the goals for the building and also reward a homeroom in each grade level, who maintains the highest percentage, a banner declaring them Homeroom Winners.
- Accelerated Reader
 - Students will be competing in a contest against other homerooms in their grade level. The winning homeroom each quarter will win a donut party for the entire homeroom.
 - Individual students who are the Top 25 in their grade level will be invited to a pizza party each quarter.
 - As a building, students will be working together to earn 50,000 AR points. If they reach the goal, the entire building will receive a reward at the end of the year. We will poll the students to determine the prize.
