

BULLYING INCIDENT REPORT
FAIRFIELD UNION LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
August 13, 2015 – December 18, 2015

Public school districts in Ohio are required to make available a report of the number of student “bullying” incidents on a semi-annual basis, and post that report on the school district website. The following are the incidents as reported by the building principals during the first semester of the 2015-2016 school year.

The Superintendent/designee must provide the Board President with a semiannual written report of all reported incidents and post the report on the District’s website. Each building will submit to the Superintendent/designee a semi-annual written report of all substantiated incidents no later than January 31 and July 31 of each year. If there have been no reports during the six month period then that information will be placed in the report and submitted as such. The Superintendent/designee will prepare a Board report for the February and August board meetings.

Bullying behavior rises to a higher level of harassment when the behavior shows a repeated pattern of events and a willful intent to ridicule, humiliate or intimidate the victim. Bullying is a pattern of repetitive and coercive behavior (overt acts) by a student, or group of students, directed toward another student or staff member that poses a serious risk or immediate perceived danger to the safety of that individual. The behavior must occur on or adjacent to school property, at school-sponsored events, on school transportation or in such a manner to seriously disrupt the educational process and/or the safety of the institution.
