1. Meeting Called to Order by the President at 7:07 p.m.
2. Attendance: President; Angi Marinacci-Young, Treasurer; Tara Graham, Secretary; Denise Hoffmann, Athletic Director; Ryan Montgomery, RMS Cross Country Coach, Mike Graham.
3. Secretary Report: Tara Graham moves to approve, Angi Marinacci-Young seconds. All approve.
4. Treasurer Report: Investment account balance is \$16,331.87. Checking balance is \$43,160.69. Review of Fall Concession Report. Need to send invoice for beverages and senior Band members head shots to the Music Booster. Review of allotments show \$28,100.00. Programs brought in \$7970 in sponsorships. Invoices for the banners are \$806. 100 Programs have been sold giving a total of \$400. Angi Marinacci-Young moves to approve, Mike Graham seconds. All approve.
5. Athletic Director Report: Currently there is not a Winter Cheer Coach and it appears that there is no interest as of this date. The position has been advertised. On Thursday, October 4th the football game will be televised. On Friday, October 5th there will be a golf outing with the staff going against the boys and girls golf teams. It will be 9 holes and take place at 3:30 p.m. at Pumpkin Valley Golf Course. Golf is in the MSL and Volleyball is in second place. Cross country is strong again this year and the boys' soccer team is undefeated. Girls soccer is vying for first or second place. There is a girls' soccer game tonight and the outcome will determine their placement. The new soccer goals are in and look very nice. The OHSAA is holding a leadership conference for sophomore and juniors and is looking for about 30 students to attend. AB helped with the Huddle assist for the basketball teams last year. Coaches would like to renew the program. \$750 each for boys' and girls' basketball teams. Girls basketball coach would like to use the allotment and have \$644.00 for 24 practice uniforms. This a new coach and he is walking into a program that needs some help. Angi Marinacci-Young moves to approve, Mike Graham seconds. All approve.

6. Old Business: Concessions: Still having issues with no-shows at some events. The question has been asked about how best to address this for future event? We had this discussion previously when the discussion came up to take over the concessions after Music Boosters pulled out. Discussion thoughts were to deduct 10% per No-Show or to not give extra dollars when teams go over their allotments. Angi Marinacci-Young makes a motion to institute a 10% deduction for No-Shows going forward. Mike Graham seconds. All approve. The homecoming parade was cancelled due to the inclement weather. It was rained out. There was an adjustment of the products that were picked up from Kroger. No napkins or cups were bought and the Apple Cider that was ordered was cut back to 8 gallons. While there were no adjustments to the number of donuts that were purchased due to them being "special ordered". The donuts were given out at school the next day in celebration for Spirit Week. Programs: Are not selling as hoped. The discussion circles about continuing to have programs or look for other avenues for sponsorships.

7. New Business: Continuing the discussion regarding sponsorship, Angi Marinacci-Young had presented a Leveled Sponsorship Program to the school board. This would help aid advertising in the digital world and the possibility of incorporating a scrolling digital advertisement on or around the scoreboard(s). This could help improve the PR and credibility. Also, there could be the possibility of having the scroll on the indoor score board as well as the possibility of TV's for the winter season. Discuss if we could collaborate with the Athletic Department and have this in place for the winter and spring or possibly have in place beginning the next fall season?

Good of the Group: Maybe have concessions open the window earlier, (6:30 p.m.) for the early arrivals since a lot of people do not have the chance to get dinner before the events.
