Fundraising

- 5 K – Cross Country charged \$15.00. There was a lot involved. They had online registration and made around \$1400.00. It was a huge undertaking. There is a company that runs 5K's for bands – Band on the Run. Will check into this company to see what the costs are. There will need to be designated teams for each are of the run.

- Christy Pizza Card – They are \$25.00 for 6 buy one get one pizza. The profit is \$7.00 per card sold (28% per card). We can have them out as long as we want.
Can pick them up with just a credit card on file or can pay for them outright.
- Stollers – We make a 27% profit. Last year we only had 22 participants. There is a \$50.00 delivery fee if we don't sell over 250 items. There is a concern with keeping things cold upon delivery.
- Laundry detergent – Good Clean Fundraising – sell buckets of laundry detergent for \$45.00. We would need forklift/pallets. They can deliver to a commercial site. Julian will talk with custodian re: use of the loading dock. Profit would depend upon number sold. Free shipping available if 100 buckets are sold.
- Millersport sweet corn festival raffle tickets
- Tami will streamline fundraising for year.

Hospitality – Athletic boosters are willing to do a meal ticket for the visiting band for a hot dog and a drink. May give pizza to visiting bands if pizza wagon available, would cut pizza into 8ths instead of 4ths.

Trailer – sign up sheet to pull trailer will be at band camp pizza party.
