After School Credit Recovery – FAQ for Parents

Who is eligible?

All students who are at risk for failing for the year in a class are eligible for this program.

Which students can participate in this program?

The primary purpose for this program is to allow failing students to complete additional work to obtain a passing grade. However, students who would like some extra help in a specific content area, or those students who do not have reliable internet may also take advantage of this hour even though it will not reflect a change in their class grade.

When does this program take place?

Students can stay for one hour after school, Monday through Thursday. This program begins on April 6th, and ends on May 20th.

- **Middle School/High School:** 2:45 pm - 3:45pm
- **Pleasantville/Bremen Elementary:** 3:45 pm - 4:45pm

How many after school sessions do I have to participate in each week?

Students have to participate in at least two days per week. Other classwork can be completed outside of the after-school sessions.

How will my quarterly grades be impacted?

If students fail a class during the quarter, they can raise their grade to the passing grade of a D. Students cannot raise their grade more than one letter grade.



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Will transportation be provided?

No, students will need to arrange transportation.

How do I enroll my student(s) in this program?

All students and parents/guardians will complete a contract that will be turned in at their building office prior to April 1st.
