MINUTES

1. Meeting Called to Order by the President at 6:03 p.m.
2. Attendance: President; Angi Marinacci-Young, Treasurer; Tara Graham, Secretary; Denise Hoffmann, Athletic Director; Andy Clark, Track Coach Mike Graham, Football Coach Sean Krupla and Keith Barr.
3. Secretary Report: Tara Graham moves to approve, Angi Marinacci-Young seconds. All Approve.
4. Treasurer Report: Investment account balance is \$17,625.45. Checking balance is \$32,184.47. Total for the accounts is \$49,809.92. Coaches have been notified of the allotment balances and we would like to see them utilize the accounts. Field maintenance could be utilized. A breakdown on the concessions for expenses and profits was shared with the group. Denise Hoffmann moves to approve, Mike Graham seconds. All approve.
5. Athletic Director Report: Mr. Clark has Sign Up Genius ready for the upcoming season and is having coaches encourage parents to use it to volunteer for their athlete's sport. Boys basketball finished First in the league and made it to the second round. Girls basketball lost in the first round. The wrestling team is going to the MSL. Indoor track is doing well and going for qualifiers in Logan. Patches have been ordered.
6. New Business: Updates on Banners; girls track has been ordered. All others are in the school. Mr. Clark reports that they are waiting on the lift and all updated banners to be on hand before putting them up. The Booster Athletic Scholarship is merit based. Applications will be available in May through the guidance office. The group will wait until final grades are posted and plan for the scholarships to be awarded at the end of the school year. The scholarship funds will be distributed to the college(s) in the fall after proof of enrollment has been met. For the spring concessions stands, two people will be needed at the fields for the grill and windows. There are more JV ball games scheduled than Varsity ball. During track events, two people will be needed for the grill, two people for the windows and eight workers inside the big outdoor stand. Ideas discussed for purchases were for ice machines in the Field House and the concession stand. Coach Krupla asked about having a washer and dryer for cleaning uniforms at

the Field House. That would have to be addressed through the district and the maintenance department to see if feasible or possible to install. Mr. Barr asked about the possibility of a golf cart for staff and possibly a gator for the athletic needs. A back stop for softball was also discussed.

7. Old Business: There are a few winter programs still available. Cathy Jude will stay on as the Concession Manager. She has done a wonderful job. Coach Krupla brought in quotes for the weight room regarding glute and hamstring machines. He spoke with others and all coaches agreed that bands will be helpful. The quote is for \$435.98. Coach Krupla also has a quote for new Gatorade bottles and coolers that total \$235.00
8. For the Good of the Group: The booster closet needs cleaned out and items that do not belong to the Athletic Boosters will be removed.
