- 4. Treasurer Report: Investment account balance is \$23,093.68. Checking balance is \$31,077.45. Total for the accounts = \$54,171.13. Winter concessions brought in \$8150.49. Denise Hoffmann moves to approve, Mike Graham seconds. All approve.
- 5. Athletic Director Report: Athletic report received via email. Not much to report currently. Girls basketball will be hosting the tournament on February 14th and the boys basketball team will be in a drawing to potentially host on February 18th. Bob Hamm is currently a dual but could be a Tri-Meet. The middle school has an upcoming track meet.
- 6. New Business: Discussion for items needed for possible upcoming tournaments and spring season. Simple items will be on hand, such as candy, suckers, and no cotton candy. It is too expensive for 100 containers and is also hard to get due to supply and demand. There are a few more boys basketball games left. There are still some issues with getting volunteers and no one signed up for the last two games. Cheer is behind in their sign ups. We will discuss the signups with the coaches and ask them to reach out to parents to cover the concession stands. We will check with the softball and baseball teams about the use of grills and think about hotdogs, buns, and chips for the outdoor stands. Sign up Genius will be opened in March for the spring season. Athletic Booster Scholarship will be discussed at the March meeting. Applications will be available to the students in April.
