Where We Are and Where We Are Going

Projects that have been completed:

- Restoration of our historic covered bridge
- Dredging of existing pond and repair to the earthen dam
- Construction of a new perimeter running and nature trail
- Eradication of invasive species around the pond and bridge area

Current projects:

- Construction of a shelter house to be used as an outdoor learning classroom
- Construction of a dock to allow for greater pond access
- Continued maintenance of trails, ponds, and covered bridge as well as the surrounding area

What's Happening?

During the 2014-2015 school year, Fairfield Union, in a partnership with the Fairfield County ESC, was awarded a Straight A Fund Grant to improve and expand our outdoor learning environments. A team of teachers are working with professionals in the area of outdoor education to revitalize the areas we already have and to build additional areas for educational purposes.

Coupled with that grant opportunity, several local individuals and organizations partnered with the district to work on various projects around the FUHS and RMS site. These partners volunteered their time and expertise to restore and improve our site for future Falcons.

In addition to the projects highlighted in this brochure, there are several smaller scale project planned, including installation of birdhouses throughout the site, trail cameras, and various other methods to increase outdoor learning.

Our goal is to revitalize and restore the outdoor learning environments we currently have and develop additional site enhancements to encourage outdoor learning opportunities for our next generation of Fairfield Union learners. To accomplish this, we need the community's assistance. Our goal is to raise \$30,000 to fund the construction of our new shelter house and various other projects around the Land Lab.
