THE HISTORY OF FFA AT FAIRFIELD UNION

1962 - Vocational Agriculture, as it was known in 1962, started with 2 teachers and 65 boys in 4 different Ag. courses. Former and current Ag. teachers at Fairfield Union: Phillip Pope, Darrell Clark, James Ketcham, Loren Young, Ray Stemen, Joe Koehler, Keller Moore, Jena Kemmerer, Judd Baker, Christine Balint, Hannah Penrose, Dakota Brame and Chris Tuner.

1970 - In the early 70's, Vocational Agriculture was renamed Agriculture Education and a few girls started to join.

2000 - By the year 2000, 35% of the students in Ag. Ed. Classes at Fairfield Union were girls.

2015 - Starting in the fall of 2015 the high school Industrial Arts program combined with the current Agriculture Education program to form one of the largest High School Vocational Agriculture Programs in the State of Ohio. Today Fairfield Union has over 300 total students in the Agriculture Science Program.
